Combat efficiency was amply evidenced with the participation in the Brigade Operation in counter-guerrillas "Caquiona" where students from the training and education courses served as commanders of Gil "A" Detachment and team of the tactical units of BR3 and as members of companies of counter-guerrilla cadres.

For the elections process, the Ayacucho and Sucre companies of last phase students under the command of Captains Paulo Rodríguez and Oscar Urbina Villamizar in development of the "Democracy Plan", attached to the Brigade, recovered in Cali 100 tons of dynamite stolen by the M-19

In August 1982 the M19 attacked the school routine bus with explosives placed in the trees, killing the driver and seriously wounding the escort soldier. Consequently, Urban Counter Guerrilla Operations and Operation of the Coordination Center were carried out. Judicial entries and searches were carried out in coordination with the National Police and DAS in compliance with a judicial order from a competent authority. The urban networks of the M-19, FARC, ELN, EPL were neutralized and a mobile column of the M-19 detected was neutralized by the Brigade in the Cauca boot.
